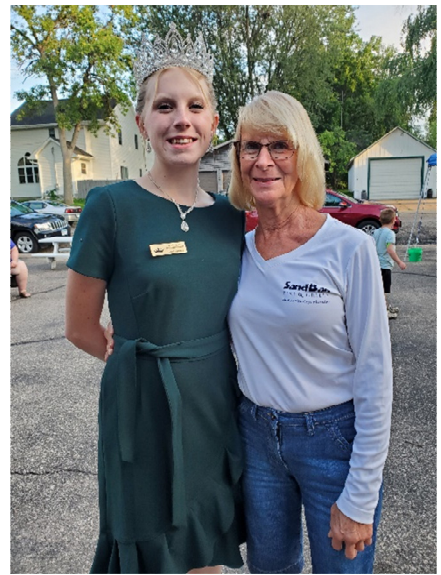
MUSIC IN THE PARK-ing LOT
