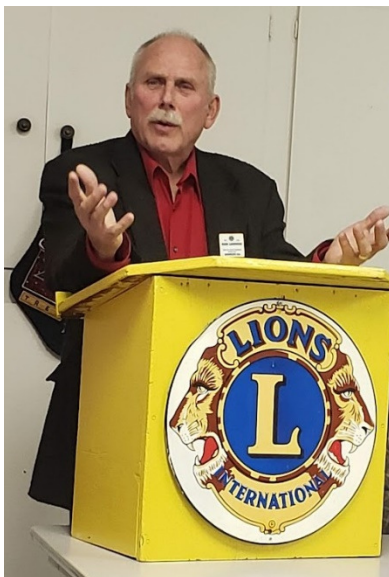
BREAKFAST WITH SANTA
