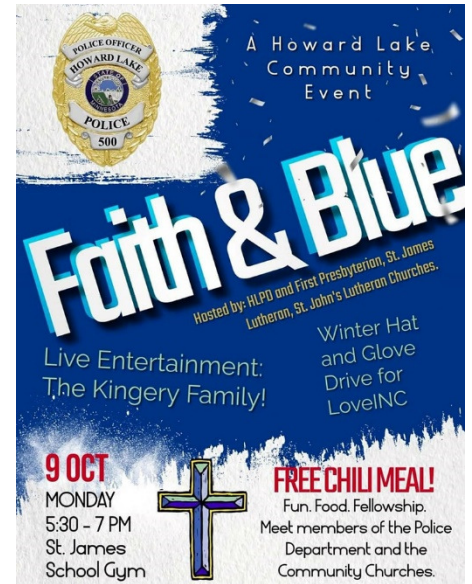

If you haven't paid your dues, you will receive a statement in the mail. Please save the club some money and send in your dues or pay at one of our October meetings. Thank You.



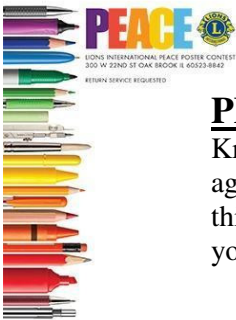
